SUMMARY OF JOB DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Operate equipment utilized to sheet and slit cloth for various production programs.
- Follow the applicable work instructions/processes; such as work order, traveler, MPS, engineer directive and other documented work instructions.
- Set up and operate all electrical controls and guides as required to slit and/or sheet rolled goods to the requirements of the MPS (Manufacturing Process Specification).
- Operate jib crane and hoist to load rolled goods onto feed mandrel.
- Make necessary adjustments to ensure conforming material is being produced.
- Thread rolled goods through material path and adjust electric eye sequence to insure cloth alignment on slitter blades.
- Operate main control panel sequences for processing material through the machine in a manual jogging or production mode.
- Identify slit material as to retain the lot number, roll number, part number and quantity.
- Screen cloth for weaving and coating defects.
- Assemble charge weights.
- Clean and sharpen blades.
- Consistently lift and install Mandrel.
- Hoist onto machine slit rolls weighing in excess of 200 lbs.
- Must be able to read a tape measure.
- Must be able to convert yards to feet.
- Additional duties assigned by Supervisor.
