- Must be an enrolled member of the Spirit Lake Tribe. Proof must be provided.
- Must not be in debt default with the Spirit Lake Tribe.
- Spirit Lake Tribe employees are not eligible for this program.
 (Ref: SLT Personnel Manual section 4.13 Educational Leave)
- Applicant must have graduated from high school or earned GED. A copy of the diploma must be provided for first time students.
- Must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 per semester. An official transcript must be provided after each completed semester.
- A letter of acceptance from the college, university, or trade school must be provided.
- Mid-Term grades or progress report for proof of satisfactory progress. Mid-term student progress report is to be completed for eligibility.
- To be considered full-time the applicant must be taking 12 credits or more. The student must complete a total of 12 credits to remain in this status. A class schedule must be provided and signed by your advisor.
- To be considered part-time the applicant must be taking 6 credits or more. The student must complete a total of 6 credits to remain in this status. A class schedule must be provided and signed by your advisor. For undergraduates, master/doctorate level, 6 credits must be taken to be full time.

Probation: Student will be notified by letter if you are placed on probation. You are placed on probation when you do not complete the required credits you signed up for, which is at least 12 if you are full-time and 6 if you are part-time. You will need to successfully complete the required credit criteria the following semester to be taken off probation. You still must be the GPA requirements.

Suspension: Student will be notified by letter when suspended. You are suspended when you fail to complete the required credits you signed up for in two consecutive terms. Reinstatement will require you to successfully complete the required credits criteria for one term. You must still meet the GPA requirements. Hence, when you are suspended you are not eligible to apply for the Spirit Lake Tribe Incentive and Scholarship until you have completed a term on your own and prove you meet criteria once again.

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Funded Amounts Each Year:

Start Up: Must be entering college for first time to receive a **one-time** startup payment.

Local Student

Full-time \$600 per year, paid half each semester Part-time \$300 per year, paid half each semester

Non-Local Student

Full-time \$1200 per year, paid half each semester Part-time \$600 per year, paid half each semester

• Student Support Services:

Full-time \$500 per year, paid half at Mid-terms or end of semester Part-time \$250 per year, paid half at Mid-terms or end of semester

- <u>Internship 2 year college/university \$500</u> Student must provide support documentation of internship. (total hrs., semester, work experience, student & advisor signature)
- <u>Internship 4 year college/university \$1000</u> Student must provide support documentation of internship. (total hrs. semester, work experience, student & advisor signature)
- If the student has earned a two-year degree/technical certificate **you will not be eligible for final grade payment,** you will be eligible for Student Support Services only each semester. If you are working toward a Bachelor's degree you will be eligible for final grade payment.
- Start-up and final grades incentives will be disbursed at the end of each semester. Mid-term grades must be turned in to the Tribal Education office for eligibility and if all necessary guidelines are met and supportive documents is on file.
- If the student receives funding and doesn't meet the minimum **term cumulative GPA of 2.0** and/or doesn't complete the minimum required credit hours, **the funding is to be paid back.**
- The Spirit Lake Tribe will not be responsible for any outstanding debt owed to the college or university that the student is attending. The debt will be the responsibility of the student.
- The Spirit Lake Tribe will not be responsible for deposits/rent for housing accommodation for students.
- No advances or loans against the funds will be permitted.
- Students other than enrolled college students are able to apply for supportive service funding/incentive, such as high school honor roll students, boarding school, GED/Certification students, and Job Corp students. These students will be assisted as funding is available. The maximum amount to be received is \$200.

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• FINAL GRADE INCENTIVE:

Students that are eligible will receive the following incentive after each semester.

Students who are working toward A.A./Two-year technology - Freshmen & Sophomore Level

Grade "A"	\$100	per credit
Grade "B"	\$75	per credit
Grade "C"	\$50	per credit

Students who are working toward BA – Junior & Senior Level

Grade "A"	\$200	per credit
Grade "B"	\$150	per credit
Grade "C"	\$100	per credit

Students who are working toward Master, Doctor, PHD Level

Grade "A"	\$300	per credit
Grade "B"	\$225	per credit
Grade "C"	\$150	per credit

Technical/Vocational Schools will utilize the conversion of quarter hours to semester hours (quarter hours x = 0.666)

• SUMMER FINAL GRADE INCENTIVE:

1-3 credits	\$200
4- 6 credits	\$300
7-9 credits	\$400
10 - 12 + credits	\$500

• HIGH SCHOOL and MIDDLE SCHOOL HONOR ROLL INCENTIVE:

Enrolled members in high school and middle school who are on the honor roll will receive the following each quarter they are on the honor roll. School will provide honor roll report.

A Honor Roll	9 th – 12 th Grade	\$100
B Honor Roll	9 th – 12 th Grade	\$50
A & B Honor Roll	5 th – 8 th Grade	\$25

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• 8th GRADE - HIGH SCHOOL - GED - CERTFICATE INCENTIVE

Enrolled members who graduate from high school, eight grade, and earned GED will receive the following. A copy of diploma or certificate must be provided before incentive will be paid. Certificates must be submitted no later than one year after completion.

8th Grade -- \$25 High School -- \$200 GED -- \$200 Certificates -- \$200

• JOB CORP ENROLLMENT:

Enrolled members will be eligible for check/purchase order in the amount of \$100. Student enrollment must be provided. Upon completion student will receive \$100 incentive. Certificate must be submitted no later than one year after completion.

• BOARDING SCHOOL STUDENTS:

Enrolled members will be eligible for check/purchase order in the amount of \$100 per semester. Boarding school will provide student enrollment for each semester.

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
