APPLICATION FOR EXCLUSION

The Spirit Lake Constitution and Bylaws as well as Title 13 of the Spirit Lake Law and Order Code vest the Tribal Council with the inherent authority of the Tribe to exclude individuals from the Spirit Lake Reservation for a variety of reasons,

Title 13 of the Spirit Lake Law and Order Code sets forth the procedures that must be filed in order for the Tribal Council to address and issue an Exclusion. The Code requires:

- 1) That a Complaint/ Petition for Exclusion be filed with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Tribal Council; and
- 2) That the Secretary-Treasurer for the Tribe send notice of a Hearing and of receipt of the Complaint/ Petition to the person against whom exclusion is sought.
- 3) The Tribal Council may enter a Temporary Emergency Exclusion Order if the Tribal Council deems that an emergency exists; and
- 4) The Tribal Council will hold a hearing and will determine the length of the hearing as well as what information is relevant to the hearing.
- 5) At the Conclusion of the Hearing the Tribal Council will either grant or deny the exclusion.
- 6) If the Exclusion is granted a Resolution and Permanent Exclusion Order will be issued and a copy of the same will be sent to the Tribal Court for enforcement and service purposes.

Should you fail to appear at the hearing the Tribal Council shall enter an Order of Exclusion against you.
- (4) You violate this order if, in addition to the prohibition set forth above, you:

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- a) Enter the Spirit Lake Reservation without the express authorization of the Spirit Lake Tribal Council; and
- b) Failure to abide by the terms of this Order may result in criminal or civil proceedings in the Spirit Lake Tribal Court.
- c) An Officer of the Fort Totten Police Department shall accompany the Respondent to retrieve any personal properties (clothes, toiletries, medication, documents of identification, or other personal items ______
