Mr. Demarce:

For the month of March I have been corresponding with students regarding the status of the tribal scholarship. I have not been given the official approval to process my student's awarded scholarships. Once I receive an official notice I will notify all of the students. I have been corresponding to nonlocal students who call or email and inquire about signing up for the program. I am happy to report that I currently have an established relationship with Lake Region State College (LRSC) with a student counselor who is helping our enrolled members get signed up for the program.

I also processed 2 part time student supportive services (midterm) incentive and 35 full time student supportive services (midterm) incentives. Students who have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher and are passing their courses will get the student supportive services incentive. Part time students get \$125 and full time students get \$250.

The third quarter honor roll lists came in for the local schools. Currently we have 2 enrolled members who made Circle of Nations honor roll list; 39 enrolled students who made Warwick's honor roll list; 16 enrolled students who made Devils Lake High School honor roll list; 54 enrolled students who made Four Winds Community High School honor roll list; 45 enrolled students who made Tate Topa's honor roll list; 32 enrolled students who made Central Middle School's honor roll list; 27 enrolled students who made the Minnewaukan Honor Roll list and I am currently waiting on Oberon, Flandreau Indian School, Crow Creek, and Chemawa for any enrolled members who made the honor roll.

I also worked on updating my tribal scholarship spreadsheet and my student's incentive spreadsheet. I worked on resolutions that Secretary Treasurer Street had given me and I kept track of all the resolutions that need to be completed. I attended the Sioux Manufacturing Corporation board meeting and recorded minutes. I also took Council meeting minutes and completed the resolutions that were passed at that meeting.
